Grey whales of Clayoquot Sound

This is the first edition of a summer sightings report of individual Grey whales in Clayoquot Sound. These sightings contribute to the documentation work of the Pacific Wildlife Foundation (PWF), who are currently compiling all sightings and identification information collected since the 1970s into a comprehensive database. Therefore, this sightings report should be viewed as a sliver of insight into effort. Grey greater whales pacific distributed throughout the Northwest in the feeding season and so this should only be used as a local catalogue.

Photo identification efforts of cetaceans in Clayoquot Sound started in the began 1970s. Dr. Darling has been monitoring the Grey whale population in Clayoquot Sound for the last 40 years. Documenting the sightings of individual whales is a powerful tool in understanding how the behaviour, range, and migratory patterns of our local whales fits into the global picture, and vice versa. The following catalogue only considers resident and 'one-time' resident Grey whales in the summer of 2019. We have followed the definition of resident Grey whales set out by the PWF, that is to say whales that were sighted in Clayoquot Sound between July 1st and November 30th, or seen in the

area for four consecutive months. We hope this catalogue may be a tool for education, scientific inquiry, as well as a channel for visitors and residents alike to connect with the natural world we are all a part of.

The Grey whale (Eschrichtius robustus) is a medium large (11m-14m to mysticete (baleen) whale; the only living representative of the family Eschrichtiidae. Grey whales are easily identified by the 7 to 15 knuckles along their dorsal ridge in place of a dorsal fin. Ranging from dark to light grey in skin colour, Grey whales have various degrees of permanent semi-permanent mottling, barnacles, and whale lice covering their body which can be used to differentiate them. Grey whales reach sexual maturity at eight years but will continue to grow until they are about 40 years old. A female grey whale will have a calf approximately every two years and 60% of the Eastern Population are assumed to be mature individuals.

There are four distinct populations of Grey whales worldwide; European whalers commercially hunted all of them between the 18th and 20th centuries. While the North Atlantic population became extinct due to over-whaling in the 1700s, the three North Pacific populations have endured at varying capacities. They are the Western (Korean) population (~100 individuals), the

Eastern (California) population (~20,000 individuals), and the Pacific Coast Feeding Aggregation (PCFA) (~240 individuals). All three Pacific populations have at different points in time dropped to counts which threatened population extinction. And yet the Eastern population is 100 times the size of the other two.

Pacific Grey whales migrate between their winter calving grounds in Baja, Mexico and their summer feeding grounds in the Bering, Chukchi, and Alaskan Beaufort Seas. The Eastern Pacific population is currently comprised of roughly 20,000 individuals. However, there is a genetically distinct population that spends the summer feeding in the waters between North California and Southeast Alaska, including Clayoquot Sound. Compared to the Eastern Pacific herd containing around twenty thousand whales, this population only comprises ~240 individuals. Unlike the greater Eastern population of Grey whales who are considered 'not at risk' by COSEWIC, this population faces greater risk of being adversely affected by human activities such as pollution, entanglements, and collisions were, therefore, categorized as 'endangered' by COSEWIC in 2018.

As major benthic feeders in shallow waters along the Eastern Pacific coast, Grey whales exert considerable influence on the structure and diversity of the ecosystems

they are a part of. Bottom feeding Grey whales stir up nutrients in the ocean floor when they plow through soft sediment searching for food. Additionally, Grey whales contribute to nutrient distribution and cycling by lifting nutrients through the water column as they surface for air. Grey whales exert a strong top-down pressure on their prey populations, shrimp (family primarily mysid Mysidacea) and porcelain crab larvae (family Porcellanidae). Grey whales can only filter large invertebrates from the sediment and smaller invertebrates are expelled near the surface where they serve as food for marine birds and fishes. Grey whale calves can also serve as a food source for transient Killer whales (Orcinus orca) along the Grey whale migratory corridor and on the feeding grounds.

In addition to their ecological significance, Grey whales have historically held an important place in the subsistence of Indigenous Peoples of Canada, including Nuu-Chah-Nulth. Aboriginal communities living along the western coast of Canada have practiced whaling for over 1500 years. While most native coastal communities historically supported themselves through local salmon runs, the Nuu-Chah-Nulth of Vancouver Island found success in whaling practices. The ability to find, kill, and process such a large prey suggest that this is a deep-seated and ancient practice. Grey whale was a

preferred species of the Nuu-Chah Nulth. The culture of these nations is saturated with the practice of whaling. Evidence of the cultural importance of whaling for the Nuu-chah-nulth is evident today in their art, stories, songs, ceremonies, the names of people and places. Whaling is one of the key adaptations that lead to establishment and support of permanent pre-settlement villages on the outer coast. The whaling methods of these nations and their sustainable management of the natural resource (Grey whales) was able to support thousands of people for hundreds of years.

In the next pages of this catalogue we have provided an overview of the season with a small amount of analysis. Although these synopses can be beneficial as a grounds for asking further questions about resident Grey whale population, assignment of significance must be done with some caution. This is due to a limitation of this report; the absence of accurate measurement of time spent searching for whales from one year to another. The years of 2017 and 2018 saw consistent effort from the PWF, with the introduction of data from individuals in the community (namely Mark Sawyer and Ashley Hoyland). 2019 saw mounting

contributions to the sightings report with effort to the PWF, Cedar Coast Field Station, and individuals in the community.


